**INTRODUCTION**—15 Points possible

- Good use of an Attention Getter (intro technique)? *Use one of 6 techniques discussed in class!*
- Shows good credibility and relates topic to audience
- Did they preview main points (thesis)? *Great thesis!*

- Reviews main point (restate thesis)?
- Provides a memorable, creative conclusion (final impression)
- Comments— *Make sure you don't end with your restated thesis! Need to leave the audience thinking!*

**DELIVERY**—40 points possible

- Eye Contact *Look up from notecard at the audience!*
- Gestures/Movements
- Vocal Expression (rate, pitch, and volume)
- Handling and appropriateness of note cards/outline/visual aides
